MATING

TURTLES REPRODUCE INFREQUENTLY (EVERY 1-3 YEARS) AND THEIR YOUNG HAVE A NATURALLY LOW SURVIVAL RATE; THEREFORE, EVERY MATING AND NESTING ATTEMPT IS INCREDIBLY IMPORTANT TO THE LOCAL POPULATION.

WHEN SEA TURTLES REACH MATURITY AND ARE READY TO REPRODUCE, THEY MIGRATE FROM THEIR FEEDING GROUNDS TO THE BEACH WHERE THEY WERE BORN.

EGGS

THE FEMALE TURTLE MAKE A NEST FOR LAYING EGGS. THE NESTING PROCESS CAN TAKE FROM 45 MIN TO 5H. A FEMALE SEA TURTLE CAN NEST SEVERAL TIMES DURING EACH NESTING SEASON AND WILL MAKE ANYWHERE FROM 2 TO 8 NESTS TO MAXIMIZE THE NUMBER OF EGGS LAID.

THE AVERAGE NEST CONTAINS BETWEEN 80 AND 200 EGGS DEPENDING ON THE SPECIES

ONCE HATCHLINGS LEAVE THE NEST, THEY ARE OFTEN NOT SEEN AGAIN UNTIL THEY RETURN TO COASTAL WATERS YEARS LATER AS JUVENILES.

HATCHLING

HATCHLING

SEA TURTLES HATCH THROUGHOUT THE YEAR BUT MOSTLY IN SUMMER. HATCHLINGS USE A CARBUNCLE (TEMPORARY EGG TOOTH) TO HELP BREAK OPEN THE SHELL. AFTER HATCHING, THE YOUNG TURTLES MAY TAKE 3 TO 7 DAYS TO DIG THEIR WAY TO THE SURFACE.

HATCHLINGS USUALLY WAIT UNTIL NIGHT TO EMERGE FROM THE NEST. EMERGING AT NIGHT REDUCES EXPOSURE TO DAYTIME PREDATORS.
